

Virtual tour of the “Berlin City Models” exhibition

The virtual tour shows the “Berlin City Models” exhibition in the Atrium of the Senate Department for Urban Development and Housing office building “Am Köllnischen Park 3”. It is a special service and intended to spark interest in a visit to the exhibition.

There are eight 360° panoramas, between which the user can move interactively and in which he or she can select the viewing direction and degree of image magnification. The good image quality and the intuitive navigation make the virtual tour an enjoyable experience and acquaint the viewer with the exhibition in a playful manner.

The eight 360° panoramas are connected with each other via hotspots. By clicking a hotspot in the picture (an arrow symbol), the viewer moves to the next selected panorama. In each panorama, the viewer can look in all directions and zoom in to view details. The virtual tour can also be viewed in full screen mode, in which the 360° panoramas look particularly impressive and give a very realistic spatial impression.

The virtual tour starts at the entrance of the exhibition. From this slightly elevated point the visitors have a wide view over the spacious glass-roofed atrium with the models “1:500 Scale Berlin Model”, “1:1000 Scale City Model”, “1:2000 Scale Tactile Model” and “1:500 Scale GDR Planning Model”. The visitor can access four more 360° panoramas located in different parts of the Atrium. From the Atrium, he or she can also access the two side rooms, the “Brochure Centre” and the “Special Exhibition Space”, in each of which there is one 360° panorama location.
