

## **Tactile Model of Central Berlin**

### Directions for visually impaired and blind people

#### **Directions from Märkisches Museum U-Bahn station (U2)**

Leave the station from the eastern end of the platform (coming from Alexanderplatz, from the rear end of the train).

Go up four flights of stairs. You are now in the middle of Wallstraße. Cross Wallstraße to the right, then immediately cross Inselstraße to the left.

Turn right into Inselstraße and follow the left sidewalk for about 80 m until you reach the next intersection.

Turn left here into Rungestraße.

Follow the left sidewalk of Rungestraße for about 200 m until you reach the next intersection. Cross the road straight ahead, Am Köllnischen Park.

Turn left into Am Köllnischen Park and follow the right sidewalk for about 60 m.

The entrance to the building Am Köllnischen Park 3 is the third entrance and comes after a row of bicycle stands.

#### **Directions from Jannowitzbrücke S-Bahn station (S5, S7, S75)**

Leave the platform from its western end (coming from Alexanderplatz, from the rear end of the train).

Go down to the station hall (by stairs, escalator or elevator), then turn left and exit the station hall. Go straight ahead to the railing outside the hall. Turn right and follow the railing for about 10 m, go up three steps, then turn left and cross the Jannowitzbrücke bridge.

Once you have crossed the bridge, stay on the sidewalk and follow Brückenstraße for about 100 m until the next intersection (with Rungestraße).

Turn right here and cross Brückenstraße on the pedestrian crossing with a traffic island.

Turn left along Brückenstraße, then immediately right into Rungestraße.

Follow the right sidewalk of Rungestraße for about 70 m.

At the next intersection, turn right into Am Köllnischen Park and follow the right sidewalk for about 60 m.

The entrance to the building Am Köllnischen Park 3 is the third entrance and comes after a row of bicycle stands.

#### **Directions in the building**

At the entrance to the building Am Köllnischen Park 3, there is a doorbell with a Braille inscription to the right of the door. You can contact the doorman by ringing the bell.

When you enter the building, the doorman's office is up two steps to your right. The doorman will accompany you to the exhibition space.

From here, tactile floor markings will lead you to the information counter.

You can also walk about 10 m straight ahead from the building entrance until you reach a railing. Turn left here and go down a staircase. From here, tactile floor markings will lead you to the models and the information counter, where you can borrow an audio set.
